Happy to be corrected but I also read somewhere that you can only use a manual controller, as I currently have, or a brivis programmable controller. Not meaning you cant use other brands but briviss networker controller with its fancy functions cant be used on this model so maybe your controller doesnt need to have

those extra wires connected because as you say they may be just dead and not doing anything. The RETURN on the thermostat is the programmed period it is currently running at. It doesn't maintain heating until preset temperature. Turning the power off and back on. This is the most common reason for it to go out on an overtemp fault. If the fan is not working it does not take the heat off the heat exchanger causing an overtemp fault. Apart from that he doesnt know what else has gone wrong. And will charge me expensive rate per hour for the next visit. That was the first thing the tech replaced but it was not the problem. After much toing and froing with heater specialists one told me that, after you have a duct collapse, it may mean that the wire that measures the heat in the duct has come loose. It comes from the unit, just above the supply vent and then runs along the top of the duct mine is underfloor so it is attached to the bottom of the house and then goes inside the duct at the first bifurcation join. Today its having problems. As I worked today I called the installers from work who advised it may have been a power surge and reset it by turning power off then on. That got it working. Mum turned it on around 8pm and nothing. Anyway I reset it and it started for a few minutes then shut down. I guess it didnt fire up the burner. Something is going on with the circuit board I think. Calling installers on monday who will either come out or get Brivis to come out and have a look. Will keep you posted. Youve saved me a lot of bother.

Ive got a 12 month old Brivis Buffalo B20 which started up and stopped after just one second. Since the heater hadnt been started for a few weeks, I guess that fits with a pilot flame not being able to start. Now its working fine. For the time being. Looking inside, I can see that there is a blue wire with one end connected to gas igniter assembly. The other end has a jumper connector, but it has come off and is hanging free. Given that there are four pins there, I dont know which pins to connect the igniter wire to. Does anyone have any suggestions Thanks. The photo you posted seems to be a different version of the control module than the one I have, even though it has the same model number and similar appearance. Also, the black round thing in the casing, bottom rhs, is absent from mine. Specifically, in my heater, the J6 pins are immediately next to the terminal strip, and are vertically aligned. I checked voltages on my module, and pin 1 shows 6 volts to ground. I dont know if that has any significance in this conversation. Given that, where else would the jumper wire be connected. I cant see any other electrical connections on the ignition system, so I assume this blue wire is the hot wire. Thanks for your help. Pics might help if possible. I just went outside and took another look. Total dumbass. I didnt see the internal details of it before because I was looking at in bright daylight, and the sun was right in my eyes. Hows that for an excuse Since it is midnight now, I will leave it for tomorrow, and double check before I do anything. I assume that if I plug the hotwire into this, it should solve the problem. I will report back tomorrow. Thanks everybody for the help so far. Man! Mucho embarrassment! Then when I looked inside, its a miracle. I could see everything. In the contrast between the bright sunlight and the shadow inside the unit, without the shade cloth, both were invisible. So I connected the hot wire, and now all is working fine.

Just in time for the heatwave. Now all I am wondering how the wire disconnected in the first place. Aliens The moral of this story is not to attempt repairs unless you are sure that you can see everything clearly. Thanks to all who offered their suggestions. The unit sometimes starts up ok but cuts out after 510 minutes and doesnt get to temperature. If I switch off the power at the outside furnace for a minute then switch it back on it will generally fire up and run again before cutting out again a short time later. Occasionally I get code 4, rollout lockout. I thought it was the thermostat so I did the obvious checks like removing the thermostat panel, cleaning the contacts and replacing the batteries. This still didnt fix the problem. Then I read that when its supposed to run but doesnt and you bridge W and R terminals at the outside unit then if it starts ok its likely a faulty thermostat. I did this test but it still wouldnt run. Knowing that the fan was running ok, All I could think why its overheating is an obstruction in the return air duct because I recently did a lot of renovations and the plumber was poking around under the house a lot. So I went under the house and found a few problems with my ducting. To start with, a duct had fallen off at a 3 way junction and this explains why I wasnt getting heat to the far end of the house. But secondary and more importantly I found the inlet air duct had collapsed to flat oval shape and looked almost flat. This would make it hard for the heater to suck air from inside the house and might explain the overheat issue. I squished the ducting round again and added a couple more suspenders. If youre having a similar error, do yourself a favour and check these things before calling a serviceman out. During the installation of the replacement unit, he found the inlet duct near the unit was collapsed and subsequently unblocked it. The newly replaced unit stopped working 2 days after the installation and called me for help.

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I then followed the wires and found the faulty temp sensor on the bottom of the Main Fan there is another sensor on the top in series to the one on the bottom. I then gave it a wack and it seems fixed the issue. After firing up the unit, it cuts out the gas around every 5 minutes due to overheating and fires up again after 1 minute or so after cooled down below the sensors threshold with hysteresis function, I hope. The issue persisted even after the replacement of the bottom sensor with a same type from the original unit. I even checked the return duct in the house, which seems having enough suction. That number of flashes gives you an indication of what is wrong. If there are no LED's lit up, the fuse may have blown. Check the users manual for fault codes, it could be many different issues. My apologies for not being so clear. There is a control board inside the heater itself. There will be some holes moulded into the cover, in one of those you will be able to view the flashing LED. Once I saw that ants had made their nest in a heater and the owner had decided to kill them with fly spray, unfortunately the owner sprayed directly onto the circuit board before Brivis had a cover on it and short circuited everything.
