You don't want to cut through your buttonhole and ruin all your work, because it is almost impossible to go back and fix it once you cut it. Make a mark through the center of the buttonhole with a fabric marker or pencil. It will stretch out after a few pass throughs. You don't want the buttonhole too large because you don't want it to sag over time or not hold your project in the right place. A little bit of snugness is good. Help please Help please I even dug out the manual and followed the instructions to sew buttonholes, in case I was forgetting a step. I'm kind of hoping a suggestion like this fixes it something so blindingly obvious I am overlooking it because then my machine isn't broken. Thanks for the suggestion, though. I gave up but I'm glad I'm not alone. Love the machine otherwise. Hopefully I can read through these other comments and try again. Though it's a pain in the ass to take it apart every time. I mistakenly tried to use the wrong buttonhole foot and it was a huge frustrating mess. AFAIK they are not universal. Watching someone else do it on youtube may help too. It should be between the two notches and not in front of them. On mine, it sits comfortably in front of them, and I have to push it back a little to get it to sit between the two notches where it should actually sit. Posting a picture of the set up might help. I have to click on the buttonhole foot, drop the needle and then raise it again. This makes the thread go into the buttonhole foot. Try nudging the fabric along, I sometimes have to coax my machine from a tough spot. Also try holding the threads behind the presser foot to give them some tension as it starts.

Sometimes threads entangle at the beginning when there's no tension, cause a small snarl then the feed dogs can't move the fabric trapped under the foot because the snarl is in the way and getting bigger by the stitch. Which button hole pattern. Can you sew in reverse, zig zag, same stitch width and length. Are you holding the tail as it starts. Does it birdsnest in any other case. I have to unplug mine from my machine to make it work. And I forget every freaking time. What I need to do is move the stitch selector knob past the buttonhole setting and back again both directions. I was using an old Kenmore that was heavy and temperamental. This new machine is a breeze to operate after you familiarize yourself with all the features. I love the self threader, which was the one feature that sold me on this model. The variable speed is also very handy. I haven't tackled any major projects yet but it made short work of a huge pile of mending I had to do. I haven't used many stitches yet but I love the possibilities. I do wish there was a storage box for the accessories instead of just a pouch in the base of the machine. I bought a little storage container to keep them handy. I read the whole booklet and started in sewing. It is so easy to use and very light if moved around. I love the pushbutton stitch on and off, because I don't have to use the foot pedal.

With MS it is difficult to hold pressure on the pedal for any length of time. The buttons are perfect and I wouldn't do without it now. The one little con is I do have a little trouble using the needle threader. The thread has to be perfectly slipped under the little hook and goes thru the needle in order to get it to thread correctly. After many tries, I finally figured that out. Would recommend this machine to anyone doing all sorts of stitching. I checked out several machines and this was the best value. I have enjoyed this machine. However, I don't know if it is just me but the auto reverse works okay but after a while the tension on the machine seems to get off somehow. So I try to fix the tension then just let the machine sit for a couple of days and that seems to work. I'm in the middle of a quilt so as soon as I finish I will take it in to get looked at. I have really enjoyed this machine. My husband is really glad that I'm using it to, I think he thought at I wouldn't. I do general sewing and quilting. I send my big projects to a longarm quilter but this machine is good for smaller projects. I don't like the way the guidelines are measured from the lefthand needle position very confusing. The light is not bright enough. I wish it didn't reset itself when you turn it on, I don't like having to write down my settings. I've had some tension issues but have solved them by making sure my bobbins were smooth no nicks to catch the thread and by using good quality thread with the same weight in the top and bottom. Then BOTH machines started having issues. Mine had to have the bobbin case replaced, and I don't know yet if that solved the issue of the thing spinning around and getting hit by the needle. My daughter's machine has E6 error, even when the machine is cleaned and no thread is in it. Not sure how it can have jammed up thread when there isn't any in the machine. While I would have bought it again before, NOW, I wouldn't recommend it.

It seems like a great machine at first, but after a few months of sewing with it, it just quits working correctly! I really like the drop in bobbin and threading process very easy. I also like the speed stitch adjustments. The only slight issue is the foot adjustment is a little low for thicker, layered fabrics. Overall the Brother CS6000i is a wonderful value for the money. It comes with several different attachments that are not usually included. Whether you have been sewing for years or just getting started this is a great purchase. I shopped and tracked reviews on several machines before making this purchase I am very pleased with the CS6000i! I must say, it could be operator error, but I'm following manual instructions. I have to keep fiddling with tension. Since so many things affect thread tension, I can't just say it's the machine when it could be me fabric choices, thread choices, proper machine threading, etc. I believe I will call Brother for some help on solving the issue. But there's much to love about the 6000i, especially the on button, needle up button, and reverse stitch button. Those are such time savers. This machine has enough stitches to keep anyone happy, and

comes with a ton of presser feet. I bought this one because I was starting a couple of quilt classes and thought it was a newer model. The description and features swayed me. However, it is a major step down from my first machine which is no longer made. The 6000i is very lightweight and seems cheaply made after using the CS8072. The space for material to the right of the needle is very small and is difficult to sew a quilt. It also vibrates when sewing, and the metal seems flimsy. It may be a good machine for a new sewer, but not for an experienced quilter. Fortunately, it's only temporary until I get a BabyLock or Janome. Please try again later. We would recommend using either Organ or Schmetz branded needles. Rethread the machine following the instructions in your manual and ensure that the foot is raised. If there is tension when pulling the thread, then the thread may be unsuitable for machine sewing and should be replaced with machine sewing thread from a reputable brand. It's possible there be a timing issue with your machine. Contact your Brother dealer to arrange a service or contact our customer service team. Make sure the presser foot is lifted before threading the machine. Set your bobbin correctly into the machine. For top loading bobbins, the thread needs to be going around the bobbin in an anticlockwise direction.

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Use the guides on your machine or refer to your instruction manual. If you have a mechanical machine, check that the foot is lowered before sewing. Computerised machines will remind you to do this. Using thread that does not pull through smoothly can cause thread breakages, poor stitching or damage to your machine. For best results, you should use a good quality, branded thread. The thread should pull through the machine with no tightness. There are 9 presser feet included in this machine: buttonhole, overcasting, monogramming, zipper, zigzag, blindstitch, button fitting, walking, and spring action quilting foot. This machine also includes a detachable wide table that is perfect for larger quilting projects. The Brother CS6000i sewing machine has been engineered for ease of use.
